## LEE VALLEY WATER ORDER

## Water Act, 1945

Notice is hereby given that the Lee Valley Water Company (hereinafter referred to as "the Company") are applying to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for an Order under section 23 of the Water Act 1945.

The counties and districts comprised wholly or partly in the area affected by the proposed Order are:

The administrative counties of Essex and Hertford and the administrative area of Greater London;

The rural districts of Braughing, Dunmow, Elstree, Epping and Ongar, Hatfield, Hertford, Hitchin, Saffron Walden, St. Albans, Ware and Welwyn.
