## HYDE BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Hyde Smoke Control Order  
No. 5/1967

Notice is hereby given that the Hyde Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 26th day of June 1967, made an Order entitled the Borough of Hyde, Smoke Control Order No. 5/1967, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area, which Order has been submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the Smoke Control Area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that that emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of June 1968, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Clerk's Department, Town Hall, Hyde, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from the 24th November 1967.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

## SCHEDULE

The area containing 249 acres or thereabouts, situate in Hyde aforesaid, bounded on its westerly side by the River Tame; on its northerly side by a line running due east from the River Tame to Croft Street and thereafter along Croft Street to Market Street; on its north-westerly side by Market Street and Stockport Road as far as the railway bridge; and on its south-westerly and southerly side by the railway line and the borough boundary with Bredbury and Romiley Urban District Council.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before 1st October 1968, or such later date as may be determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.
