Notice is hereby given that the Hyde Borough Council has made an Order under subsections (1), (2) and (3) of section (1) and subsection (4) of section (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, the effect of which provides that no person except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform shall cause or permit the waiting

of a vehicle (other than to enable persons to board or leave the vehicle, goods to be loaded or unloaded or the vehicle to be used in connection with funeral or building operations) in the lengths of roads described in the Schedule below.

Church Street on both sides from the westerly side of Great Norbury Street for a distance of 125 feet in a north-easterly direction.

Borough of Hyde (Market/Street/Stockport Road/Lumn Road/Smithy Lane) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Hyde Borough Council has made an Order under subsections (1), (2) and (3) of section 1 and subsection (4) of section 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, the effect of which will be to provide that no person except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform shall cause or permit the waiting of a vehicle, in the lengths of road described in the first column of the Schedule below, during the hours specified in the second column of the Schedule.

A vehicle may wait (a) to enable a person to board or leave it; (b) to enable it to be used for funeral or building operations; and (c) for goods to be loaded or unloaded, except where otherwise provided in the second column of the Schedule.

The Order becomes operative on 4th December 1967.

SCHEDULE

Lengths of Road in the Borough of Hyde

1. *Smithy Lane, on its southerly side*
2. *Stockport Road, on its north-easterly side, from its junction with Smithy Lane to a point 120 feet north-west of its junction with Lumn Road.*
3. *Stockport Road, on its north-easterly side, from a point 120 feet north-west of its junction with Lumn Road for a distance of 230 feet in a south-easterly direction.*
4. *Lumn Road, on its westerly side, between its junctions with Stockport Road and Smithy Lane.*
5. *Lumn Road, on its southerly side, for a distance of 40 feet in an easterly direction from its junction with Stockport Road.*
6. *Market Street, on its southerly side, for a distance of 110 feet in a north-westerly direction from its junction with Stockport Road.*
7. *Stockport Road, on its south-westerly side, for a distance of 280 feet in a south-easterly direction from its junction with Market Street.*

- Between the hours of 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and between 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. from Mondays to Fridays (inclusive).
- At any time. (Loading and unloading of goods - vehicles prohibited between 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and between 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. Mondays to Fridays inclusive.)
- At any time. (Loading and unloading of goods vehicles prohibited between 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and between 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. Mondays to Fridays inclusive.)
