PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

BRIGHOUSE BOROUGH COUNCIL

*Borough of Brighouse (Lane Head No. 13)
Smoke Control Order, 1967*

Notice is hereby given that the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Brighouse acting by the Council of the said Borough in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956 on the 6th day of November 1967, made an Order entitled the Borough of Brighouse (Lane Head No. 13) Smoke Control Order 1967 declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding ten pounds unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of June 1969 or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Brighouse at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 24th day of November 1967.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may, by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the Confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

That part of the Borough of Brighouse shown coloured pink on the map referred to in the Order comprising 137.8 acres approximately and being contained within an imaginary line commencing at a point at the junction of Granny Hall Lane and Smithy Carr Lane with Lightcliffe Road and thence in a south-westerly direction along the centre of Granny Hall Lane across Halifax Road thence along the centre of Mill Lane to its junction with Wood Bottom Lane thence in a south-easterly direction along the edge of Brighouse Wood thence in a south-westerly direction to Brighouse Wood Lane thence in a south-easterly direction along the centre of Brighouse Wood Lane to a point opposite the north-westerly boundary of the dwellinghouse known as Vista Bellissimo, Brighouse Wood Lane thence in a westerly direction for approximately 10 yards thence in a generally south south-easterly direction along the west south-westerly boundary of Vista Bellissimo, Brighouse Wood Lane thence in a north-easterly direction to the northern corner of Field No. 531 thence in a south-easterly direction to the eastern corner of Field No. 531, thence in a north-easterly direction to the northern corner of Field No. 533A thence in a southern direction to the north-west corner of Field No. 534, thence in an easterly direction to the centre of Halifax Road thence in a generally south-easterly direction to the southern corner of Rydings Park thence in a north-easterly direction to the eastern corner of Rydings Park thence in a north-westerly direction to the north-western corner of Field No. 553 thence in a generally easterly direction to the south-western end of Haigh Street thence in a north-westerly direction to the north-west corner of Field No. 551 thence in a westerly direction along the boundary of Field No. 555 thence in a north-westerly direction to the

southern corner of Field No. 549 thence in a north-easterly direction to the junction with Bonegate Road and Churchfields Road thence in a north-westerly direction along the centre of Bonegate Road to the junction of Waterloo Road Thornhill Bridge Lane and Garden Road thence in a generally north-easterly direction along Thornhill Bridge Lane to the junction with Bradford Road thence in a northerly direction along Bradford Road to a point opposite the northern boundary of Field No. 651 thence in a generally westerly direction along the boundary of Elm Wood to the centre of Bracken Road East thence in a south-westerly direction to the south-eastern corner of Field No. 659 thence in a generally western direction following the boundary of Field No. 659 thence in a southerly direction to the centre of Smithy Carr Lane thence in a north-westerly direction along Smithy Carr Lane to an unmade road leading from Smithy Carr Lane to Nos. 86 and 86A Smithy Carr Lane thence in a north-easterly direction along the centre of the unmade road for a distance of approximately 33 yards thence in an easterly direction along the southern boundary of Nos. 82 and 84 Smithy Carr Lane thence in a northerly direction along the same boundary, thence in a generally north-westerly direction to the northerly boundary of No. 86 Smithy Carr Lane thence in a westerly direction along the northern boundary of Nos. 86 and 86A Smithy Carr Lane to its junction with Lightcliffe Road thence in a southerly direction along the centre of Lightcliffe Road to the point of commencement aforesaid.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11(4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of November 1968, or before a later date determined by the Minister.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Colne, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 1st December 1967.
