- (a) From the County Boundary at the River Erewash to a point 50 yards north from the southern boundary of Halls Road;
- (b) From the southern boundary of Victoria Street in a north-east direction to its junction with Nottingham Road.

Nottingham Road

From its junction with Derby Road in a north-east direction to the eastern boundary of Cemetery Road. Brookhill Street

From its junction with Derby Road for a distance of 50 yards.

Toton Lane

From its junction with Derby Road for a distance of 107 yards.
