Lengths of road in the County Borough of Bournemouth

Commercial Road

(i) north side, from its junction with Avenue Road to its junction with Poole Hill;

(ii) northern branch, both sides, from its southern extremity to its junction with Avenue Lane on the north side and to the western side of the

service lane adjoining number 25 The Triangle on the south side;

(iii) south side, from a point opposite the western boundary of the property numbered 164 Commercial Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 35 feet;
