#### CHELMSFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

(A) *The Borough of Chelmsford (New Street and Rectory Lane) (Prohibition of Waiting) Variation Order, 1967.*

(B) *The Borough of Chelmsford (Cottage Place Etc.) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1967*

(C) *The Borough of Chelmsford (Cottage Place Etc.) (One Way) Order, 1967*

Notice is hereby given that on the 15th day of November 1967, the Chelmsford Borough Council made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967. The effect of (A) above is to so vary the provisions of the Borough of Chelmsford (New Street and Rectory Lane) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1964, as to provide that, subject to the savings contained in such Order, the waiting of vehicles will also be prohibited between the hours of 7.15 a.m. and 9 a.m. Mondays to Fridays in any of the lengths of roads specified in such Order.

The effect of (B) above is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on weekdays in Church Street, Cottage Place and Legg Street. Exemptions enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from a vehicle and will enable a vehicle to wait upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from a vehicle or to enable a vehicle to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the roads or any services therein.

The effect of (C) above is that no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the roads specified in the first column hereunder otherwise than in the direction specified in the second column:

#### First Column

Church Street—the whole length.

Cottage Place (part)—that part of Cottage Place lying between Church Street and Legg Street.

Cottage Place (part)—that part of Cottage Place lying between New Street and Legg Street.

Legg Street—the whole length.

#### Second Column

From east to west, that is to say towards Cottage Place.

From south to north, that is to say towards Legg Street.

From east to west and from north to south, that is to say towards Legg Street.

From west to east, that is to say towards New Street.
