The Rhyl Urban District Council (Traffic Regulation) (High Street No. 6) Order 1967

Notice is hereby given that on 14th November 1967 the Rhyl Urban District Council made an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, the effect of which will be:

- (a) to revoke the existing restrictions on the waiting of vehicles in relation to (inter alia) the lengths of road as set out in the first column of the Schedule hereto; and
 (b) to impose in their place the restrictions on the waiting of vehicles described in the second column of the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

1. Length of Road	2. Nature of Restrictions
<i>High Street</i>	
(i) <i>Easterly Side</i> —from its junction with the southerly kerb line of East Parade for a distance of 75 feet in a southerly direction.	No waiting at any time except (i) to allow persons to board or alight from a vehicle; and (ii) to enable a vehicle to be used for certain building, etc., operations. No loading or unloading of goods permitted.
(ii) <i>Easterly Side</i> —from a point 75 feet in a southerly direction from its junction with the southerly kerb line of East Parade for a distance of a further 75 feet in a southerly direction.	No waiting at any time except (i) to allow persons to board or alight from a vehicle; (ii) to enable a vehicle to be used for certain building, etc., operations; and (iii) to permit the loading or unloading of goods for a period not exceeding 30 minutes for any one delivery.
(iii) <i>Westerly Side</i> —from a point opposite the southerly kerb line of East Parade for a distance of 102 feet in a southerly direction.	No waiting at any time except (i) to allow persons to board or alight from a vehicle; and (ii) to enable a vehicle to be used for certain building, etc., operations. No loading or unloading of goods permitted.

The Order will come into effect on 8th December 1967.

RAMSGATE BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Ramsgate (Various Roads) (Traffic Regulation) Order, 1968

Notice is hereby given that the Ramsgate Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which will be to prohibit (with the usual exceptions) the waiting of vehicles as follows:

<i>Newington Road</i> —		
(i) On the west side from a point on the southern boundary of No. 34 southwards to a point 50 yards south of the southernmost pier of the railway bridge.	8 a.m. to 6 p.m.	On all days of the week throughout the year.
(ii) On the east side from a point opposite the southern boundary of No. 24 southwards to a point 50 yards south of the southernmost pier of the railway bridge.	8 a.m. to 6 p.m.	On all days of the week throughout the year.
<i>The Paragon</i> —		
On the south side from the western boundary of No. 14 Paragon to the junction with Addington Street.	24 hours daily.	On all days of the week from the 1st July to the 30th September in each year.
<i>Cannon Road</i> —		
(i) On the south-east side from a point 45 feet from its junction with High Street to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary of No. 10 Cannon Road.	8 a.m. to 6 p.m.	On all days of the week throughout the year.
(ii) On the north-western side from its junction with Ellington Road north-eastwards for a distance of 33 yards.	8 a.m. to 6 p.m.	On all days of the week throughout the year.
<i>Chapel Place</i> —		
(i) On the south-east side from a point 45 feet with its junction with High Street to its junction with Elms Avenue.	24 hours daily.	On all days of the week throughout the year.
(ii) Along the lengths of the north-west side as shown on the plan, which may be inspected during normal office hours at the Municipal Buildings, Ramsgate.	24 hours daily.	On all days of the week throughout the year.
<i>Chichester Road</i> —		
(i) On the south side from its junction with Newington Road westwards for a distance of 91 yards.	24 hours daily.	On all days of the week throughout the year.
(ii) On the north side from a point 57 yards west of its junction with Newington Road westwards for a distance of 175 yards.	24 hours daily.	On all days of the week throughout the year.
<i>Access Road off Melbourne Avenue</i> —		
From its junction with Melbourne Avenue eastwards for a distance of 27 yards on both sides of the access road to the entrance to the garages.	24 hours daily.	On all days of the week throughout the year.
