Notice is hereby given that the Ramsgate Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which will be to prohibit (with the usual exceptions) the waiting of vehicles as follows:

## Chapel Place-

(i) On the south-east side from a point 45 feet with its junction with High Street to its junction with Elms Avenue.
(ii) Along the lengths of the north-west side as shown on the plan, which may be inspected during normal office hours at the Municipal Buildings, Ramsgate.

## Chichester Road-

(i) On the south side from its junction with Newington Road westwards for a distance of 91 yards.
(ii) On the north side from a point 57 yards west of its junction with Newington Road westwards for a distance of 175 yards.
Access Road off Melbourne Avenue-
From its junction with Melbourne Avenue eastwards for a distance of 27 yards on both sides of the access road to the entrance to the garages.
