The Walsall (Limited Waiting) Experimental Traffic Order 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Walsall County Borough Council propose to apply to the Minister of Transport for an extension for a further period of fifteen months from the 23rd January 1968 of the present Order made on the 19th day of September 1967 under Section 28 of the Road Traffic Act 1962, the effect of which is to prevent vehicles from waiting for longer than 30 minutes in any one hour on the sides of the roads specified in Part I of the Schedule hereto and for longer than 10 minutes in any one hour on the sides of the roads specified in Part II of the Schedule hereto. The Order only applies between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m.

Exceptions will permit vehicles to wait:

(a) to enable a person to board or alight from a vehicle.

(b) to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded.

(c) to enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with building or demolition work or the maintenance or improvement of the road or of any services therein.

Objections to the proposal must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 27th December 1967.

The Walsall (No Waiting) Experimental Traffic Order No. 2, 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Walsall County Borough Council propose to apply to the Minister of Transport for an extension for a further period of fifteen months from the 23rd January 1968 of the present Order made on the 19th day of September 1967 under section 28 of the Road Traffic Act 1962 the effect of which is to prohibit vehicles waiting in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule hereto during the respective peaks stated at the head of each part of the Schedule.

The following exemptions shall apply:

1. Roads comprised in Part I.

Vehicles may wait:

(a) to enable a person to board or alight;

 (b) to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded;
 (c) to enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with building or demolition work or the maintenance or improvement of the road or of any services therein.
