turned into a cul de sac. Nash followed the car until it stopped. The passenger alighted and threw a bottle at the Officer which smashed against his motor cycle. The car then drove away, again at a fast speed, but failed to make a turn and collided with a lamp standard. The driver and his passenger jumped out and ran off pursued by Nash. Both men then attacked the Officer, knocked him down, and kicked and punched him. Nash, however, held down the driver until other Officers arrived and took him into custody.
