Junior Lance Corporal Sinclair suggested to his companion that they try and help, and despite the odds, convinced him that they should put to sea.

By this time, the off shore wind had increased considerably, but nevertheless they relaunched their cance and paddled seawards. In the rough water the cance was uncontrollable and capsized. Junior Lance Corporal Bell succeeded in reaching the shore safely. Canoe was uncontrolable and capsized. Jumor Lance
Corporal Bell succeeded in reaching the shore safely,
but Junior Lance Corporal Sinclair was carried out
to sea and his body has never been recovered.

This brave young man, without any thought for
his own safety, returned to the sea from which
