

SCHEDULE

Waiting restricted on weekdays between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m.

High Street from its junction with the Market Place (Ellis & Son (Burton) Limited) to its junction with New Street, a distance of 85 yards.

Lichfield Street from the west boundary of Number 10 to its junction with Fleet Street and Park Street, a distance of 126 yards.

Fleet Street from its junction with Abbey Street (west side) to its junction with Stapenhill Viaduct, a distance of 133 yards.

Green Street from its junction with Fleet Street to its junction with Bond Street (south side), a distance of 115 yards.

Waiting restricted on weekdays between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. to no more than 30 minutes or if a period of less than 30 minutes has elapsed since the vehicle was last parked in the street concerned.

Station Street from a point 89 yards west of its junction with High Street to a point 134 yards west of its junction with High Street, a distance of 45 yards.

Waiting restricted on weekdays between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. to no more than 60 minutes or if a period of less than 60 minutes has elapsed since the vehicle was last parked in the lengths of road concerned.

Lichfield Street from the south side of Number 9 to its junction with New Street, a distance of 84 yards.

New Street from a point 36 yards west of its junction with High Street to a point on the north side 128 yards east of its junction with Union Street, a distance of 166 yards and on the south side 121 yards east of its junction with Orchard Street, a distance of 174 yards.

Fleet Street from its junction with Lichfield Street to its junction with Abbey Street (west side), a distance of 122 yards.

The Order contains the usual exception permitting waiting for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading, unloading, building works and funeral corteges.

BLACKPOOL COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of Blackpool (No Waiting and Limited Waiting) (Various Streets) No. 2 Order, 1968

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Blackpool propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, the effect of which will be to restrict waiting on the following lengths of road and on the side or sides indicated:

(a) No waiting throughout the year, 24 hours each day:

Lengths of road	Side or sides
Devonshire Road (Talbot Road to Devonshire Square)	West side.
Devonshire Road (Devonshire Square to Caunce Street)	East side.
Devonshire Road (Warwick Road to Talbot Road)	East side.
Park Road (Westmorland Avenue to Lune Grove)	West side.
Westmorland Avenue (10 yards east and west from its junction with Park Road)	Both sides.
Park Road (10 yards north from its junction with Westmorland Avenue) ...	Both sides.
Park Road (10 yards south from its junction with Westmorland Avenue) ...	East side.
Grasmere Road (Ashton Road to Westmorland Avenue)	West side.
Preston Old Road (40 yards east of Wren Grove to 20 yards east of Royal Avenue)	South side.

(b) Limited waiting (sixty minutes in any two hours) between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. throughout the year:

Length of road	Side
Devonshire Road (Caunce Street to Warwick Road)	East side.

The usual exceptions in favour of loading and unloading goods from parked vehicles will be inserted in the Order.

BLACKPOOL COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of Blackpool (No Waiting) (Cromwell Road, Claremont Road and Handsworth Road) Order, 1968

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Blackpool propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting for 24 hours each day throughout the year, on the following lengths of road and on the side or sides indicated:

Length of road	Side or sides
Cromwell Road (for a distance of 20 yards south from its junction with Claremont Road).	Both sides.
Cromwell Road (for a distance of 20 yards north from its junction with Handsworth Road).	Both sides.
Claremont Road (for a distance of 20 yards west from its junction with Cromwell Road).	South side.
Claremont Road (for a distance of 10 yards east from its junction with Cromwell Road).	South side.
Handsworth Road (for a distance of 20 yards west from its junction with Cromwell Road).	North side.
Handsworth Road (for a distance of 10 yards east from its junction with Cromwell Road).	North side.

The Order will contain the usual exceptions in favour of unloading goods for adjacent premises from parked vehicles.
