Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Cornwall River Authority by the North and Mid Cornwall Water Board, Town Hall, Wadebridge, Cornwall, to vary the licence, serial number 15/49/272/S/9, to abstract water from the Board's reservoir at Porth, near Newquay, S.W. 848 623.

The variations applied for are as follows: From the 1st April 1968 the quantities authorised to be abstracted not to exceed 80,120 gallons per hour (at present 61,120 gallons per hour), 1,803,000 gallons per day (at present 1,473,000 gallons per day) and 401,000,000 gallons per year (at present 536,000,000 gallons per year).
