Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Lancashire River Authority by the Fylde Water Board whose Head Office is situate at Sefton Street in the County Borough of Blackpool for a licence to abstract the following quantities of water from the River Wyre at Scorton in the County of Lancaster at the following points of abstraction: 18,000,000 gallions per day at National Grid Reference 501500 and 501496.

Further details of the application are:

(1) That the abstraction should be confined to the occasions when the supply of water permitted to be abstracted from the Barnacre and Stocks Reservoirs is inadequate.

(2) The Licence shall be subject to certain limita-tions according to the flow of water in the river and the season of the year.
