*The County of Carmarthenshire (Road to Sticks and Foreshore, Llanstephan) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1968.*

#### CHRISTCHURCH BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Christchurch (Southcliffe Road/Avon Run Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1968.*
