Proposed Imposition of Speed Limits at Christian Malford

Notice is hereby given that the Wiltshire County Council intend to apply to the Minister of Transport for consent to the making under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 of Orders, the effect of which will be that:

1. That length of the Swindon to Chippenham Road (A.420) at Christian Malford, between a point 23 yards south-west of the centre of the Avon River Bridge, and a point 700 yards north-eastwards, shall be subject to a speed limit of 40 m.p.h., and

2. The following lengths of road in Christian Malford shall be subject to a speed limit of 30 m.p.h.:
