

PIPE-LINES ACT 1962

Notice of Application for a Pipeline Construction Authorisation

IMPERIAL CHEMICAL INDUSTRIES LIMITED

Notice is hereby given that Imperial Chemical Industries Limited in accordance with the provisions of Part I of the First Schedule to the Pipe-lines Act, 1962, that it has made an application to the Minister of Power for the grant of an authorisation for the construction of a pipe-line approximately $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles in length (constituting a cross-country pipeline under the provisions of section 7 (1) of the Act), to convey ethylene between its Castner-Kellner Works at Runcorn and a point in the Parish of Sutton on the existing pipeline owned by Shell U.K. Limited and conveying ethylene between Stanlow and Carrington.

A copy of the map that accompanied the application, on which is delineated the route of the proposed pipeline, can be inspected in Room 1127, Ministry of Power, Thames House South, Millbank, London S.W.1, or at the office of the Company at The Heath, Runcorn, Cheshire.

Any objection to the application must be made in writing and addressed to the Minister of Power at Thames House South, Millbank, London S.W.1, not later than 16th March 1968, and should bear the reference PET 16/108/A11 and state the grounds of objection.

WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS

London Borough of Greenwich

Notice is hereby given that the Greater London Council are about to consider a proposal that they should make an Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which would be, in the London Borough of Greenwich:

1. to impose restrictions on waiting by vehicles between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in:

Abbey Wood Road

- (a) the south side, between its junction with Knee Hill and the eastern kerb-line of Conference Road;
- (b) the north side, between its junction with Harrow Manor Way and a point opposite the party wall of No. 175 and No. 177 Abbey Wood Road.

Archery Road

- (a) the north-east side:
 - (i) between its junction with Eltham High Street and a point opposite the southern boundary of Eltham C. of E. Primary School;
 - (ii) between a point 60 feet south-east of the southern-eastern kerb-line of Gourcock Road and a point opposite the party wall of No. 36 and No. 38 Archery Road;
- (b) the south-west side:
 - (i) between its junction with Eltham High Street and a point 60 feet north of the northern kerb-line of Eltham High Street;
 - (ii) between a point 105 feet north of a point opposite the southern boundary of Eltham C. of E. Primary School and a point opposite the northern boundary of that school.

Artillery Place between its junction with Frances Street and a point 15 feet west of a point opposite the western flank wall of No. 38 Artillery Place.

Basildon Road between its junction with Bostall Hill and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 7 and 9 Basildon Road.

Bexley Road the south side, between its junction with Eltham High Street and a point opposite the south-western kerb-line of Elderslie Road.

Blunts Road between its junction with Eltham High Street and a point opposite the party wall of No. 14 and No. 16 Blunts Road.

Bostall Hill between its junction with Plumstead High Street and a point 10 feet east of a point opposite the party wall of No. 46 and No. 48 Bostall Hill.

Brookhill Road between its junction with Nightingale Place and a point 5 feet north of a point opposite the northern flank wall of No. 3 Brookhill Road.

Burrage Road between its junction with Plumstead Common Road and a point 100 feet north of the northern kerb-line of Plumstead Common Road.

Charlton Church Lane

(a) the south-west side:

(i) between a point 60 feet south-east of the southern kerb-line of Woolwich Road and the north-western kerb-line of Nadine Street;

(ii) between a point opposite the party wall of No. 115 and No. 117 Charlton Church Lane and a point opposite the south-eastern flank wall of No. 163 Charlton Church Lane;

(iii) between its junction with The Village and a point 15 feet north-west of a point opposite the south-easternmost flank wall of Wilson House;

(b) the north-east side:

(i) between a point opposite the south-easternmost flank wall of No. 23 Charlton Church Lane and a point opposite the north-western flank wall of No. 61 Charlton Church Lane;

(ii) between a point 25 feet north-west of a point opposite the party wall of No. 85 and No. 87 Charlton Church Lane and the north-western kerb-line of The Heights;

(iii) between a point 25 feet north-west of a point opposite the party wall of No. 161 and No. 163 Charlton Church Lane and its junction with The Village.

Charlton Park Road between its junction with The Village and a point 8 feet west of a point opposite the western flank wall of No. 2 Charlton Park Road.

Charlton Road between its junction with The Village and a point 10 feet north-east of a point opposite the north-eastern flank wall of No. 206 Charlton Road.

Court Road the north-east side, between its junction with Court Yard and a point opposite the southernmost flank wall of the Eltham Congregational Church.

Court Yard

(a) the north-west side, between its junction with Eltham High Street and a point opposite the south-western flank wall of No. 18 Court Yard;

(b) the south-east side, between its junction with Eltham High Street and its junction with Court Road.

Dobell Road between its junction with Well Hall Road and a point opposite the party wall of No. 1 and No. 3 Dobell Road.

*Elm Terrace**Eltham High Street*

(a) the north side:

(i) between a point opposite the party wall of No. 40 and No. 42 Eltham High Street and the easternmost flank wall of Christ Church (R.C.) Presbytery;

(ii) between a point opposite the western flank wall of No. 247 Eltham High Street and the south-western kerb-line of Elderslie Road;

(b) the south side:

(i) between a point opposite the western flank wall of No. 60 Eltham High Street and a point opposite the easternmost flank wall of Christ Church (R.C.) Presbytery;

(ii) between a point opposite the western flank wall of No. 247 Eltham High Street and its junction with Bexley Road.

Footscray Road

(a) the north-east side, between its junction with Eltham High Street and a point 60 feet south-east of a point opposite the southern kerb-line of Messeter Place;
