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## PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

### LONDON BOROUGH OF BROMLEY

*The London Borough of Bromley No. 7 Smoke Control Order, 1968*

Notice is hereby given that the Bromley London Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 on the 5th day of February 1968 made an Order entitled the London Borough of Bromley No. 7 Smoke Control Order, 1968, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the limitations and exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he prove that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Bromley, Kent, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from the 16th day of February 1968.
