Provision is made to empower the Port Authority to pay subscriptions or Shoreham Harbour Act, 1926. Provision is made to empower the Port Authority to pay subscriptions or donations to Associations, Public Institutions or Charities and to defray the proper expenses connected with the affairs of the Port Authority.
