#### LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1930

*East Ham, Ilford Bridge to Loughton, Abridge to Hallsford Bridge, and Chipping Ongar to Canfield Internal Drainage Districts.*

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 4(3) and 14 of the Land Drainage Act 1930, as applied by the Water Resources Act 1963, has now made an Order confirming a Scheme submitted to him by the Essex River Authority, under section 4 (1) (b) of the Land Drainage Act 1930, making provision for the abolition of the East Ham, the Ilford Bridge to Loughton, the Abridge to Hallsford Bridge, and the Chipping Ongar to Canfield Internal Drainage Districts.

The Scheme affects land in the London Boroughs of Barking, Newham and Redbridge, and land in the Urban District of Chigwell, the Parishes of Aythorpe Roding, Broxted, Great Canfield, Hatfield Broad Oak, High Roothing, Little Canfield, Little Easton, Leaden Roding, Margaret Roding, Takeley and White Roothing in the Rural District of Dunmow, and the Parishes of Abbess Beauchamp and Berners Roding, Bobbingworth, Fyfield, High Ongar, Kelvedon Hatch, Lamborne, Magdalen Laver, Moreton, Navestock, Norton Mandeville, Ongar, Stanford Rivers, Stapleford Abbots, Stapleford Tawney, Stondon Massey, Theydon Bois, Theydon Garnon, Theydon Mount and Willingale in the Rural District of Epping and Ongar in the County of Essex.

The Order will become final and have effect as an Act of Parliament unless during the period ending with 18th March 1968, a memorial is presented to the Minister by some person or body affected and having an interest sufficient for the presentation of a memorial (as prescribed in Article 6 of the Land Drainage (River Authorities) General Regulations 1965, S.I. 1965/443) praying that the Order shall be subject to special parliamentary procedure.

These Regulations consolidate with certain amendments the provisions of the National Insurance (Members of the Forces) Regulations 1949 (S.I. 1949/875) as amended.

The amendments made by these Regulations consist chiefly of new provisions (in Part II of the Regulations) applying for the purposes of the National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland) 1966, the provisions of the National Insurance Act 1965 and the regulations thereunder relating to the members of Her Majesty's forces.

The remaining amendments are of a minor or consequential character.
