

**127. Wellington Square****128. Whitehead's Grove**

On both sides, between its junction with Elystan Street and a point 35 feet south-west of the south-western kerb line of Sloane Avenue.

**PART II**

Restricted street where the expression "the prescribed hours" means the time between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive.

**King's Road**

(a) On the north-west side, between its junction with Anderson Street and its junction with Manresa Road;

(b) On the south-east side, between its junction with Walpole Street and its junction with Glebe Place.

**PART III**

Restricted streets where the expression "the prescribed hours" means the time between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Mondays to Fridays inclusive and between 8 a.m. and 1.30 p.m. Saturdays.

**1. Chelsea Bridge Road**

So much as lies in the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea.

**2. Chelsea Embankment**

On both sides, between the boundary of the City of Westminster and a point 100 feet west of the western kerb line of Old Church Street.

**3. Cheyne Walk**

On the north side, between the archway under No. 33 Cheyne Walk and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 26 and 27 Cheyne Walk.

**4. Cromwell Place**

On both sides, between its junction with Cromwell Road and a point 30 feet south of the southern kerb line of Cromwell Road.

**5. Exhibition Road**

On both sides, between its junction with Cromwell Road and its junction with Thurloe Place.

**6. Queen's Gate**

(a) On the west side, between its junction with Cromwell Road and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 73 and 74 Queen's Gate;

(b) On the East side, between its junction with Cromwell Road and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 132 and 133 Queen's Gate.

**7. Queensberry Place**

On both sides, between its junction with Cromwell Road and a point 25 feet south of the southern kerb line of Cromwell Road.

**PART IV**

Restricted streets where the expression "the prescribed hours" means at any time.

**1. Albert Bridge**

So much as lies in the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea.

**2. Chelsea Bridge**

So much as lies in the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea.

**3. Whitehead's Grove**

On both sides, between its junction with Sloane Avenue and a point 35 feet south-west of the south-western kerb line of Sloane Avenue.

**THE EIGHTH SCHEDULE****ABOVE REFERRED TO (LOADING AND UNLOADING RESTRICTIONS)****PART I**

Restricted streets where waiting to load or unload is prohibited between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Mondays to Fridays inclusive and between 8 a.m. and 1.30 p.m. Saturdays.

**1. Chelsea Bridge Road**

On the South-West side,

(i) between its junction with Royal Hospital Road and a point 50 feet South-East of a point opposite the South-Eastern boundary wall of the (disused) burial ground;

(ii) between its junction with Chelsea Embankment and a point 250 feet North-West of the

North-Western kerb line of Chelsea Embankment.

**2. Chelsea Embankment**

On both sides, between its junction with Chelsea Bridge Road and a point 150 feet South-West of the South-Western kerb line of Chelsea Bridge Road.

**3. Exhibition Road**

On both sides, between its junction with Thurloe Place and its junction with Cromwell Road.

**4. Queen's Gate**

On both sides, between its junction with Cromwell Road and a point 100 feet South of the Southern kerb line of Cromwell Road.

**PART II**

Restricted streets where waiting to load or unload is prohibited between 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

**1. Chelsea Bridge**

So much as lies in the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea.

**2. Chelsea Bridge Road**

On the South-West side, between a point 50 feet South-East of a point opposite the South-Eastern boundary wall of the (disused) burial ground and a point 250 feet North-West of the Northern kerb line of Chelsea Embankment.

**PART III**

Restricted streets where waiting to load or unload is prohibited between 8 a.m. and 10 a.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive and between 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

**1. Chelsea Embankment**

On the North side, between its junction with Royal Hospital Road and a point opposite the Eastern flank wall of No. 17 Chelsea Embankment.

**2. Cheyne Walk**

On the North side, between the archway under No. 33 Cheyne Walk and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 26 and 27 Cheyne Walk.

**PART IV**

Restricted streets where waiting to load or unload is prohibited between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Mondays to Fridays inclusive and between 8.30 a.m. and 1.30 p.m. Saturdays.

**1. Cromwell Place**

(a) On the West side, between its junction with Harrington Road and a point 30 feet North of the Northern kerb line of Harrington Road;

(b) On the East side, between its junction with Thurloe Street and a point 5 feet South of a point opposite the party wall of No. 26 Cromwell Place and No. 45 Thurloe Street.

**2. Fulham Road**

(a) On the South-East side,

(i) between its junction with Sydney Street and its junction with Pond Place;

(ii) between its junction with Sloane Avenue and its junction with Lucan Place;

(b) On the North-West side,

(i) between its junction with Elm Place and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 100 and 102 Fulham Road;

(ii) between its junction with Sydney Place and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 66 and 68 Fulham Road.

**3. Harrington Road**

(a) On the South side, between its junction with Glendower Place and a point opposite the Western flank wall of Harrington Court;

(b) On the North side, between its junction with Queen's Gate and a point 75 feet East of the Eastern kerb line of Queen's Gate.

**4. Old Brompton Road**

The edge of the carriageway fronting Nos. 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 and 12 Old Brompton Road.

**5. Pelham Street**

On the North side,

(i) between its junction with Brompton Road and a point 150 feet West of the Western kerb line of Brompton Road;

(ii) between its junction with Thurloe Street and a point 45 feet South-East of a point oppo-
