6. *Thurloe Street*

- (a) On the North side, between its junction with Cromwell Place and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 43 and 45 Thurloe Street;
- (b) The edge of the carriageway fronting Nos. 40, 42, 44, 46 and 48 Thurloe Street.

PART V

Restricted street where waiting to load or unload is prohibited between 8.30 a.m. and midnight throughout the week.

Whitehead's Grove

On both sides, between its junction with Sloane Avenue and a point 35 feet South-West of the South-Western kerb line of Sloane Avenue.

PART VI

Restricted streets where waiting to load or unload is prohibited between 8.30 a.m. and 10 a.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive and between 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

1. *Exhibition Road*

- (a) On the East side, between its junction with Thurloe Street and a point 60 feet North of the Northern kerb line of Thurloe Street;
- (b) On the West side, between its junction with Thurloe Street and a point 15 feet North of the Northern kerb line of Thurloe Street.

2. *Fulham Road*

- (a) On the North-West side,
- (i) between its Northernmost junction with Pelham Crescent and its junction with Pelham Street;
- (ii) between its Southernmost junction with Pelham Crescent and its junction with Sydney Place;
- (iii) between its junction with Neville Street and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 100 and 102 Fulham Road;
- (b) On the South-East side,
- (i) between its junction with Lucan Place and a point 70 feet South-West of the South-Western kerb line of Lucan Place;
- (ii) between its junction with Pond Place and a point 45 feet North-East of a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 155 and 157 Fulham Road;
- (iii) between a point opposite the South-Western kerb line of Neville Street and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 251 and 253 Fulham Road.

3. *Glendower Place*

4. *Harrington Road*

- (a) On the North side, between its junction with Cromwell Place and a point 15 feet West of the Western kerb line of Queensberry Way;
- (b) On the South side,
- (i) between a point opposite the party wall of No. 1 Harrington Road and No. 2 Old Brompton Road, and a point opposite the Western flank wall of Harrington Court;
- (ii) between its junction with Queen's Gate and a point 75 feet East of the Eastern kerb line of Queen's Gate.

5. *Lucan Place*

On both sides, between its junction with Fulham Road and a point 50 feet South-East of the South-Eastern kerb line of Fulham Road.

6. *King's Road*

- (a) On the North-West side, between its junction with Manresa Road and its junction with Chelsea Manor Street;
- (b) On the South-East side, between its junction with Glebe Place and its junction with Chelsea Manor Street.

7. *Neville Terrace*

On the North-East side, between its junction with Fulham Road and a point 100 feet North-West of the North-Western kerb line of Fulham Road.

8. *Oakley Street*

- (a) On the North-East side,
- (i) between its junction with King's Road, and a point 70 feet South-East of the South-Eastern kerb line of King's Road;

(ii) between its junction with Cheyne Walk and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 51 and 52 Oakley Street;

(b) On the South-West side,

- (i) between its junction with King's Road, and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 107 and 108 Oakley Street;
- (ii) between its junction with Cheyne Walk and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 53 and 54 Oakley Street.

9. *Old Brompton Road*

- (a) On the north-west side,
- (i) between its junction with Glendower Place and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 12 and 14 Old Brompton Road;
- (ii) between its junction with Clareville Street and a point 120 feet north-east of the eastern kerb line of Queen's Gate;
- (b) On the south-east side,
- (i) between its junction with the western access roadway to Melton Court and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 27 and 29 Old Brompton Road;
- (ii) between a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 101 and 103 Old Brompton Road and a point opposite the north-eastern kerb line of Clareville Street.

10. *Old Church Street*

- (a) On the north-east side, between its junction with Fulham Road and the north-western kerb line of South Parade;
- (b) On the south-west side, between its junction with Fulham Road and its north-westernmost junction with Queen's Elm Square.

11. *Onslow Gardens* (north-easternmost north-west to south-east Arm).

- (a) On the north-east side, between its junction with Old Brompton Road and a point 60 feet south-east of the south-eastern kerb line of Old Brompton Road;
- (b) On the south-west side, between its junction with Old Brompton Road and a point 100 feet south-east of the south-eastern kerb line of Old Brompton Road.

12. *Pelham Street*

- (a) On the north side, between a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 19 and 21 Pelham Street and a point 35 feet south-east of a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 7 and 9 Pelham Street.
- (b) On the south side,
- (i) between its junction with Onslow Square and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 19 and 21 Pelham Street;
- (ii) between its junction with Fulham Road and a point 150 feet west of the western kerb line of Fulham Road.

13. *Queen's Gate*

- (a) On the east side, between its junction with Old Brompton Road and a point 100 feet north of the north-western kerb line of Old Brompton Road;
- (b) On the west side, between its junction with Old Brompton Road and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 104 and 105 Queen's Gate.

14. *Royal Hospital Road*

On the south-east side, between its junction with Chelsea Embankment and a point opposite the north-eastern flank wall of No. 59 Royal Hospital Road.

15. *Selwood Terrace*

On the south-west side, between its junction with Fulham Road and a point 60 feet north-west of the north-western kerb line of Fulham Road.

16. *Stanhope Gardens*

- (a) On the south side, between its junction with Queen's Gate and a point 70 feet west of the western kerb line of Queen's Gate.
- (b) On the north side, between its junction with Queen's Gate and a point 100 feet west of the western kerb line of Queen's Gate.

17. *Sydney Place*

- (a) On the south-west side, between its junction with Fulham Road and a point 10 feet north-west of a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 3 and 4 Sydney Place.
- (b) On the north-east side, between its junction with Fulham Road and a point 5 feet south-east
