(i) between its junction with Fulham Road and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 11 and 13 Sydney Street;

(ii) between its junction with King's Road and a point 100 feet north-west of the north-western kerb line of King's Road;

(b) On the north-east side,

(i) between its junction with Fulham Road and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 8 and 10 Sydney Street,

(ii) between its junction with King's Road and a point 150 feet north-west of the north-western kerb line of King's Road.

19. Thurloe Place

On the north-west side between its junction with Exhibition Road and its junction with Cromwell Place.

20. Thurloe Street

(a) On the north side, between its junction with Exhibition Road and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 43 and 45 Thurloe Street,

(b) On the south side, between a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 16 and 18 Thurloe Street and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 38 and 40 Thurloe Street.
