## NORTHAMPTONSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Northampton (King's Cliffe) (Railway Bridge No. 20) (Weight Restriction) Order, 1968.*

Notice is hereby given that the Northamptonshire County Council has applied to the Minister of Transport for confirmation of an Order made by them under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle the weight of which, whether laden or unladen, exceeds 13 tons from proceeding in that length of the County road (green lane) from King's Cliffe to Westhay Wood which is carried by the bridge over the railway line.

A copy of the Order and a plan showing the length of road affected by the Order may be inspected at the offices of the undersigned during normal office hours until the 9th March 1968.

Objections to the Order must be sent to the Secretary, Ministry of Transport (UT) at St. Christopher House, Southwark Street, London S.E.1, by the 9th March 1968 and a copy sent to the undersigned.

## NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Norfolk (Hunstanton) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1968*

Notice is hereby given that on the 7th February 1968, the Norfolk County Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, the effect of which is as follows:

(a) To revoke the County of Norfolk (Westgate, Hunstanton) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1960, and The County of Norfolk (Hunstanton) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1963.

(b) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles in the following lengths of road:

1. Northgate, west side from junction Cliff Terrace to junction Greevegate.

2. Northgate, east side, from junction south boundary Church Close to junction Greevegate.

3. Church Street, east side from junction Westgate to junction Austin Street.

4. Greevegate, north side from junction Church Street to junction Northgate.

5. Greevegate, north side from junction Northgate to junction Golden Lion Road.

6. Le Strange Terrace, west side from junction Southend Road to a point approximately 80 yards northwards.

7. St. Edmunds Terrace, west side from junction Westgate to Central Car Park entrance.

8. St. Edmunds Terrace, east side from junction Westgate to junction Greevegate.

9. St. Edmunds Terrace, north side from junction High Street to St. Edmunds Terrace, east side.

10. Westgate, north side from junction Le Strange Terrace to junction St. Edmunds Terrace.

11. Westgate, south side from Thaxters Garage to junction Sandringham Road.

12. Westgate, north side from junction High Street to junction Church Street.

13. Westgate, north side from junction Church Street to junction Valentine Road.

14. Sandringham Road, both sides from junction Westgate to 30 yards east of junction Avenue Road.

15. Homefields Road, both sides from junction Westgate to 50 yards South of Avenue Road.

(c) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles between

9 a.m. and 8 p.m. during the months of May to September in the following lengths of road:

1. Cliff Parade, west side from junction Lincoln Square North to junction Beach Terrace Road.

2. Seagate Road, east side from junction Seagate to Leach's House.

(d) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. during the months of May to September in the following length of road:

1. Northgate, west side from junction Lincoln Square South to junction Cliff Terrace.

(e) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles during the months of May to September in the following lengths of road:

1. Lighthouse Close, both sides.

2. Lighthouse Lane, both sides.

3. Cliff Parade, east side from junction Lincoln Square North to junction Beach Terrace Road.

4. Greevegate, north side from junction Golden Lion Road to junction Cliff Parade.

5. Greevegate, south side from junction St. Edmunds Terrace to junction Cliff Parade.

6. Beach Terrace Road, both sides from junction Cliff Parade to junction Seagate.

7. Seagate, both sides from junction Beach Terrace Road to 40 yards west of junction Seagate Road.

8. Seagate Road, both sides from Leach's House to junction South Beach Road.

9. Southend Road, both sides from junction Westgate to junction South Beach Road.

10. Park Road, both sides from junction Southend Road to 60 yards east of junction Southend Road.

11. South Beach Road, north side from junction Southend Road to junction Seagate Road.

12. Unadopted road between Golden Lion Hotel and Cliff Parade from junction Cliff Parade eastwards for 100 feet.

(f) To limit to 30 minutes the waiting of vehicles between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. in the following lengths of road:

1. Northgate, east side from junction Lincoln Square South to junction South Boundary Church Close.

2. Greevegate, south side from junction Church Street to junction St. Edmunds Terrace.

3. High Street, both sides from junction Westgate to junction Greevegate.

4. Westgate, south side from junction Sandringham Road to junction Homefields Road.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the roads or the services therein, or as part of a funeral cortege.

## NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County Council of Norfolk (Church Street and Sunk Road Bridges, Little Walsingham) (Weight Restriction) Order, 1967.*

Notice is hereby given that on the 5th February 1968 the Minister of Transport confirmed the above-named Order made by the Norfolk County Council under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is (i) to prohibit any vehicle the weight of which, whether laden or unladen, exceeds five tons from proceeding in that length of Church Street which is carried by the bridge 130 yards south-east of junction Road B.1105 and (ii) to prohibit any vehicle the weight of which, whether laden or unladen, exceeds 20 tons from proceeding in that length of Sunk Road which is carried by the bridge 100 yards south of junction Road B.1388.
