

is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1962, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the making of the amendment, he may, within six weeks from the 16th February 1968, make application to the High Court.

The proposals dealt with in the amendment comprise the Town Map for Clay Cross and a new part to the approved Written Statement for the County Development Plan.
