Notice is hereby given that on the 16th February 1968 the Cardiff City Council made an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 the effect of which is to introduce alternating unilateral waiting restrictions between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday in the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule hereto and to limit waiting to one hour in two on that side of the road on which vehicles are not for the time being prohibited from waiting.

Alternating Unilateral Restrictions

1. Albany Road, between a point 200 ft. east of its junction with City Road and Mackintosh Place and (i) on its north side Wellfield Road; and (ii) on its south side, a point 100 ft. west of its junction with Cottrell Road.

2. Broadway, between a point 200 ft. east or ns unction with Clifton Street and its junction with

Harold Street.

'3. City Road, between (i) on its west side, a point 30 ft. north of its junction with the Parade and a point 150 ft. south of its junction with Richmond Road; (ii) on its east side, a point 250 ft. south of its junction with Albany Road and a point 350 ft. north of its junction with Newport Road.

4. Clifton Street, between its junction with Newport Road and its junction with Iron Street and Diamond

Street.

5. Crwys Road, between a point 200 ft. south-east of its junction with Cathays Terrace and Fairoak Road and a point 230 ft. north-west of its junction with Richmond Road and Mackintosh Place except for the following lengths (i) the south-west side, between a point 150 ft. south-east of its junction with Woodville Road and a point 150 ft. north-west of that junction; (ii) the north-east side between a point 500 ft. north-west of its junction with Mackintosh Place and a point 740 ft. north-west of that junction; (iii) between a point 540 ft. north-west of its junction with Richmond Road and a point 780 ft. its junction with Richmond Road and a point 780 ft. north-west of that junction.

6. Cyncoed Road, between its junction with Bettws-

y-coed Road and its junction with Sherborne Avenue.
7. David Street, between a point 50 ft. south of its junction with Little Frederick Street and a point 50 ft. north of its junction with Bute Terrace.
8. Wellfield Road, between its junction with Albany Road and Bangor Street and (i) on its west side, a point 100 ft. south of Ninian Road and (ii)

on its east side Penylan Road.

9. Whitchurch Road, between its junction with North Road and a point 200 ft. north-west of its junction with Cathays Terrace and Fairoak Road except for that length of the north-east side from a point 100 ft. north-west of Banastre Avenue to a point 115 ft. south-east of Banastre Avenue.
