### COTSWOLD WATER BOARD

*Water Act, 1945—Section 40*

*The West Shropshire Water Board Order, 1968*

Notice is hereby given that the West Shropshire Water Board are about to apply to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for an Order under sections 9 and 50 of the Water Act 1945.
