## PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

### RUGBY BOROUGH COUNCIL

#### *The Rugby (No. 9) Smoke Control Order, 1968*

Notice is hereby given that the Rugby Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 on the 14th day of February 1968, made an Order entitled the Rugby (No. 9) Smoke Control Order 1968, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be made a smoke control area, which Order has been submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

By virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

Copies of the Order and the Map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Rugby, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 1st day of March 1968.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may, by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
