*The City and County Borough of Cardiff (Mackintosh Place) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1968*

10. The Paddock from Clover Street for a distance of 500 feet ...	From east to west
11. Railway Street from the link road between Maidstone Road and Railway Street immediately to the south of the Alexandra Hotel to Maidstone Road.	From south to north
12. Rhode Street from Richard Street to High Street ...	From south to north
13. Richard Street from Clover Street to James Street ...	From west to east
14. The spur road between Railway Street and Maidstone Road immediately to the north of the Alexandra Hotel.	From west to east
15. Union Street from New Road to High Street ...	From south to north
16. Whittaker Street from New Road for a distance of 191 feet ...	From south to north

There is exempted from the Order any mechanical road cleansing vehicle during specified hours. All previous Orders for one-way streets within the Borough are revoked.
