EAST MIDLANDS GAS BOARD

The Gas (Declaration of Calorific Value) Regulations 1949

and

The Gas (Declaration of Calorific Value) (Amendment) Regulations 1951

Whereas the East Midlands Gas Board, being an Area Board for the purpose of the Gas Act 1948 proposed to charge for gas supplied from their Natural Gas Governor Plant to be sited adjacent to the Rockingham-Uppingham Road at Caldecott in the county of Rutland according to the number of therms supplied.

It is hereby declared by the Board that the calorific value of the gas supplied from the said Gas Governor Plant will be 1,000 British Thermal Units per cubic foot and that this Declaration will take effect generally on and after the 1st June 1968.

This Declaration shall take effect for the purpose of calculating the charge to be made to any consumer supplied from the said Gas Governor Plant immediately after the first reading of that consumer's meter after the 1st June 1968.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

BIRKENHEAD COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of Birkenhead (Oxton Road) (Experimental) (Extension) Traffic Order, 1967

Notice is hereby given that on the 22nd day of November 1967 the Birkenhead County Borough Council made an Order under sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which was to supersede for a period of three months from the 1st day of December 1967, provisions of the County Borough of Birkenhead (Various Streets) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 1966, so far as that Order relates to that part of the south-east side of Oxton Road between Cook Street and Quarry Bank Street and to substitute therefore a prohibition of waiting during peak hours and a time limit of one hour at certain other periods and notice is hereby given that it appearing to the said Council that the said period of three months was insufficient to assess the results of the said Order of the 22nd day of November 1967, the said Council made on the 20th day of February 1968 a further Order, the effect of which is to extend the above-mentioned provisions for a further three months from the 29th day of February 1968 to the 31st day of May 1968, and the Minister of Transport has consented to the above extension in accordance with section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967.
