

3. The north-east side of that length of the trunk road, known as North Street, which extends from a point 40 feet north-west of its junction with West Street to a point 40 feet south-east of its junction with Cross Lane.

4. That length of the trunk road, known in part as North Street, in part as New Road and in part as Llangurig Road, which extends from a point 40 feet south-east of its junction with Cross Lane to a point 435 feet north-west of its junction with Church Street.

#### SCHEDULE 2

The south-west side of that length of the Cardiff-Llangurig Trunk Road (A.44), known as North Street, at Rhayader in the County of Radnor, which extends from a point 40 feet north-west of its junction with West Street to a point 40 feet south-east of its junction with Cross Lane.
