Highways Act, 1959

Urban District Council of Corby (St. James Industrial Estate) Public Path Diversion Order, 1968
Notice is hereby given that the above Order made on the 24th day of June 1968, is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Its effect will be to divert the public right of way running from a point on St. James Road at the north-east corner of the land occupied by S. Gore Limited southerly for approximately 145 feet thence westerly and south-westerly for approximately 295 feet to a line running from the said point at the north-east corner of the land occupied by S. Gore Limited westerly for approximately 282 feet thence southerly for approximately 213 feet.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at the Council Offices, Corby and may be inspected free of charge between 9 a.m. and 5.30 p.m. on weekdays Monday to Friday.

Any objection or representation concerning the Order may be sent in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, before the 2nd day of August 1968, and should state the grounds on which it is made.

MARKET BOSWORTH RURAL DISTRICT COUNCIL

Notice of Confirmation of Public Path Order
Highways Act, 1959

The Market Bosworth Rural District Council (Ibstock) (Public Paths Q89 (Part) and Q90 (Part)) Diversion Order, 1968.

Notice is hereby given that on the 25th day of June 1968, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed with modifications the above Order.

Its effect is to divert the public right of way running from Spring Cottages, Spring Road, Ibstock in a north-easterly and then northerly direction to a point in Leicester Road, Ibstock approximately 40 yards to the east of its junction with Richmond Road, Ibstock, a total distance of approximately 963 yards, to a line running from the said Spring Cottages firstly in a north-westerly and then in a generally north-easterly direction at the rear of properties in the said Leicester Road to the said point in Leicester Road approximately 40 yards to the east of its junction with the said Richmond Road, a total distance of approximately 1,240 yards. The old foot-path shall cease to be a public right of way as from the 17th day of July 1968.

A copy of the confirmed Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at and may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, Market Bosworth, between 8.30 a.m. and 12.30 p.m. and between 1.30 p.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays.

The Order becomes operative as from the 2nd day of July 1968, but if any person aggrieved by

the Order desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act, 1959, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the approval of the Order he may, within six weeks from the date of publication of this notice, make application to the High Court.

SOLIHULL COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

CIVIC AMENITIES ACT, 1967

Designation of Conservation Areas

Notice is hereby given that the Solihull County Borough Council as local planning authority in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by section 1 of the Civic Amenities Act, 1967, have designated the following areas within the County Borough of Solihull as Conservation Areas, being areas of special architectural or historic interest, the character and appearance of which it is desirable to preserve and enhance:

Area I Solihull Central Area

An area of approximately 21 acres which takes in the greater part of the High Street area of the old Solihull town centre. It contains properties on the north side of Station Road from the old Post Office to High Street, the west side of Poplar Road from Station Road to number 26, the east side of Poplar Road from the service road to High Street, the south side of Station Road from the service road to High Street, both sides of High Street, the Square, the north side of Park Road from High Street to Malvern House and the south side of Park Road from St. Alphege School to High Street including the Oliver Bird Hall which fronts Church Hill Road.

Area II Knowle Village

An area of approximately 14 acres which takes in the greater part of Knowle Village centre. It contains properties on the east side of High Street from the Wilsons Arms to Milverton House (opposite Station Road) together with numbers 2-4 (Kenilworth Road and 2-10 Wilsons Road, and the west side of High Street from Lodge Road to Station Road together with numbers 2-14 Station Road.

Copies of the plans showing the boundaries of the Conservation Areas together with copies of brief written statements setting out the local planning authority's aims in relation to these Conservation Areas is available for public inspection at my office during normal office hours.
