The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that they have made an Order under sections 1, 2 and 13 of the Import Duties Act 1958.

Viz: The Import Duties (General) (No. 6) Order, 1968.

This Order gives effect to an United Kingdom undertaking to implement in full on 15th July, instead of by stages, certain of the Kennedy Round tariff reductions of particular interest to less developed countries.

The tariff headings covered by the undertaking are shown in the Schedule to the Order and to these has been added heading 21.01(A) (unmixed chicory). This is necessary to preserve for practical reasons, the existing, and intended final Kennedy, alignment between the full and commonwealth preference rates of this heading and those of heading 09.01(C) (mixtures of coffee and chicory) which is among the items of particular interest to less developed countries covered by the Schedule.

The Order comes into operation on 15th July 1968, and has been published as Statutory Instrument 1968 No. 1030.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1962
