The Trunk Road (Abergele Road, Old Colwyn, Colwyn Bay) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1968

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State has extended the existing waiting restrictions at Abergele Road, Old Colwyn, Colwyn Bay by an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of any vehicle between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. in either of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule below.

Exemptions are provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary

for a person to board or alight from the vehicle ; to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle ; to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein ; or to enable the vehicle to be used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

The proposed restrictions will not apply to a stage carriage or an express carriage.

SCHEDULE

Those lengths of the Chester—Bangor Trunk Road (A.55), known as Abergele Road, at Old Colwyn, Colwyn Bay, in the county of Denbigh, which extend:

(a) from its junction with Victoria Road to a point 70 feet west of that junction ; and

(b) from its junction with Coed Coch Road to a point 75 feet south-east of that junction.
