Pay of Vehicle Maintenance Workers in British **Road Services**

The member companies of the B.R.S. Federation Ltd., subsidiaries of the Transport Holding Company, have negotiated an agreement with the unions repre-senting their engineering maintenance and repair senting grades which provides for pay increases ranging from 40s. per week for skilled staff to 13s. 4d. per week for unskilled staff.

In pursuance of their powers under section 2 (1) of the Prices and Incomes Act, 1966, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employ-ment and Productivity and the Minister of Transport hereby refer to the National Board for Prices and Incomes for examination the question of the pay of vehicle maintenance workers in British Road Services and the scope for increased productivity.
