

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Great Ouse River Authority by the Mitford and Launditch Rural District Council whose offices are situate at The Guildhall, Dereham, Norfolk, for a licence to abstract the following quantities of water from a borehole at Tittleshall, Norfolk map reference T.F. 889.209: namely 1,000 gallons of water per hour, 9,500 gallons per day and 1,850,000 gallons per year.

Further details of the application are that these quantities are in addition to the quantities which the Council are already authorised to abstract from the same borehole by Licence of Right Serial No. 6/33/58/71: namely 1,000 gallons of water per hour, 10,500 gallons per day, and 2,900,000 gallons per year.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

RAMSBOTTOM URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Urban District of Ramsbottom No. 2 Smoke Control Order 1968

Notice is hereby given that the Ramsbottom Urban District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956, on 22nd August 1968 made an Order entitled "The Urban District of Ramsbottom No. 2 Smoke Control Order 1968", declaring the area described in the first Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

The properties listed in the Second Schedule shall be exempt from the provisions of the Order.

By virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of September 1969 or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order (and of the map referred to therein) may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, Ramsbottom, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from the 2nd September 1968.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

FIRST SCHEDULE

An area bounded on the north by the public footpath from Lammy Bank to Brooksbottom, along the northerly and easterly sides of Brooksbottom Mill to the River Irwell thence continuing along the River in an easterly and thence northerly direction to a point where Park Brook discharges, following the course of the Brook in an easterly direction to Pinfold; on the east by Bury Old Road; on the south by the southerly boundary of the Urban District; on the west past the rear of the houses 33

and 35 Hall Street and thence in a north-westerly line west of Railway Street to the north-westerly boundary of Robin Road; all which area is more particularly described and delineated on the map referred to in the said Order and is thereon coloured green.

Houses numbered 167 to 199 odd numbered inclusive, Railway Street, Summerseat.

WHITLEY BAY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Whitley Bay Smoke Control Order No. 5, 1968

Notice is hereby given that the Whitley Bay Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956, on the 31st July 1968, made an Order entitled the Borough of Whitley Bay Smoke Control Order No. 5, 1968, declaring the area described in the first Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemption provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if on any day after the Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the Smoke Control Area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 (ten pounds) unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include Anthracite, Coke and other Carbonised fuels, Gas and Electricity.

The classes of fire places in the area which are specified in the Second Schedule hereto shall be exempted from the operation of the said section 11, upon the conditions specified in respect thereof in the said Second Schedule.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before the 1st November 1969, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Municipal Offices, Whitley Bay, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from 6th September 1968.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

FIRST SCHEDULE

From the junction with Front Street and Pykerley Road in a north-west direction via Pykerley Road by the disused bridge over the railway and by the west boundary fences of houses in Uplands and the west and north curtilage of Valley Gardens Secondary School and the Grammar School to the former Blyth Railway. In a south-east direction via the railway to the north boundary of Churchill Playing Fields then via the north and east boundary of the Churchill Playing Fields to Marine Avenue. Via Marine Avenue and Front Street to junction with Pykerley Road.

Classes of Fireplaces

Fireplaces in buildings, or parts of buildings separately occupied without gas supply.	Only authorised fuels, as declared by regulations under the Clean Air Act, 1956, and kindling sticks and paper shall be used in the fireplaces.
