PRICES AND INCOMES ACT 1966

INCREASE IN STANDARD SCALE OF MOTOR CAB FARES IN THE METROPOLITAN AREA

Direction under section 5 (4) extending the period within which the National Board for Prices and Incomes must publish their report

Whereas the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity and the Secretary of State for the Home Department, in pursuance of their powers under section 2 (1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, referred the abovementioned question to the National Board for Prices and Incomes for examination and have published the text of the reference in the Gazette on 28th June 1968;

- 2. And whereas by section 5 (3) of the Act, but subject to section 5 (4), the Board are required to make their report so as to allow publication within three months of the said date;
- 3. Now, therefore, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity and the Secretary of State for the Home Department, in pursuance of their powers under the said section 5 (4), hereby direct that the said period of three months be extended by one month.

REFERENCE TO THE NATIONAL BOARD FOR PRICES AND INCOMES

Synthetic Organic Dyestuffs and Organic Pigments Prices

The First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity, and the Board of Trade consider it desirable, in view of the notifications received by the Board of Trade from certain manufacturers of dyestuffs and organic pigments of their proposals to increase prices, that the prices of these products should be examined by the National Board for Prices and Incomes.

Accordingly, in pursuance of their powers under section 2 (1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity, and the Board of Trade, hereby refer to the National Board for Prices and Incomes for examination the question of manufacturers' prices of synthetic organic dyestuffs and organic pigments.
