The copies of extracts of the Development Plan, the Inspector's Report and the Statement so deposited will be open for inspection, free of charge, by all persons interested during normal office hours.

The amendment became operative as from the 18th day of October 1968, but if any person aggrieved by it desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1962, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any Regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the making of the amendment, he may, within six weeks from the 18th day of October 1968, make application to the High Court.
