The Surrey County Council (Roke Lane, Whitley) One Way Revocation and Traffic Regulation Order 1968.

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

The Administrative County of West Sussex (Rustington: Box Tree Avenue and Sea Lane) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1968.

Notice is hereby given that on the 24th October 1968 the West Sussex County Council made an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting by vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule hereto.

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

The Administrative County of West Sussex (Shoreham-by-Sea) (Prohibition of Driving) Order, 1968

Notice is hereby given that the West Sussex County Council have applied to the Minister of Transport for confirmation of an Order made by them under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which will be to:

- (1) prohibit vehicles entering or leaving St. Nicholas Lane, Shoreham-by-Sea at its junction with the Steyning Road (A.283) at a point 78 feet north of the Worthing-Shoreham Road (A.27);
- (2) prohibit the driving of vehicles (except those requiring access to properties fronting the roads) in the lengths of roads set out in the Schedule hereto; and
- (3) revoke the existing Traffic Orders which control the driving of vehicles in the above lengths of road.
