

## WEST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of the West Riding of Yorkshire (Regent Street and Valley Road, Hebden Bridge) (One-Way Traffic) Order, 1968*

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which will be that no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to those lengths of road in Column 2 of the said Schedule.

An exemption in the Order enables the use of mechanical road cleansing vehicles on the said lengths of road between the hours of 6 a.m. and 5 p.m.

A copy of the proposed Order and of a map showing the lengths of road in question may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of either (i) the County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire (Room 87), County Hall, Wakefield, or (ii) the Hebden Royd Urban District Council, Council Offices, Hebden Bridge.

Objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made, must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 26th November 1968.

That length of Regent Street which extends from its junction with Valley Road to its junction with Hangingroyd Lane.

That length of Valley Road which extends from its junction with Regent Street to its junction with St. Georges Street.

From south-east to north-west.

From south-west to north-east.

The proposals dealt with in the amendment comprise the Town Map for Buxton and a new part to the approved Written Statement for the County Development Plan.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Housing and Local Government has considered the proposals for alterations and additions to the above Development Plan submitted by the Council on 7th December 1966, and relating to land within the Urban District of Gainsborough which is bounded on the north by Lord Street, Parnell Street, Gladstone Street, Church Street and Market Street, on the east by Heaton Street and its extension to

Hickman Street as far as the junction with Wembley Street, on the south from this junction along Wembley Street to the River Trent and thence north to the line of North Street, and proposes to amend the plan accordingly subject to a number of modifications to the proposals.
