Notice is hereby given that on the 25th October 1968 the Brighton County Borough Council made Orders under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 the effect of which is to revoke the Brighton Corporation (Park Road) (No Waiting) Order 1965 and to prohibit waiting—

(a) in Eastern Road from 45 feet west of the western kerb line of Abbey Road to the western kerb line of Eaton Place;

(b) in Tilbury Place from the southern boundary of the Brighton Girls' Club southwards for 10 feet;

- (c) on the west side of Tilbury Place from a point 166 feet north of the northern kerb line of Carlton Hill northwards for 18 feet;
- (d) on the east side of Tilbury Place from the northern kerb line of Carlton Hill northwards for 139 feet;
- (e) on the west side of Grosvenor Street from the northern kerb line of Edward Street northwards for 170 feet;
- (f) in Park Road from the western kerb line of Coldean Lane to the western boundary of No. 5 Park Road;
- (g) on the north side of Park Road from the eastern kerb line of Rushlake Road to the western boundary of No. 5 Park Road;
- (h) on the north side of South Road from the western kerb line of that part of Preston Road which is north of South Road to a point 45 feet west of that kerb line;
- (i) in Southover Street from the south-eastern kerb line of Lewes Road to a point 45 feet south-east of that kerb line; and
- (j) between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any weekday on the north-east side of Southover Street from a point 45 feet south-east of the south-eastern kerb line of Lewes Road to the north-western kerb line of Hanover Terrace.

The Orders contain the usual provisions permitting vehicles to wait for persons to board or alight or goods to be loaded or unloaded or to enable the vehicle to be used for any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic or the maintenance of the roads or the services therein and will come into operation on the 15th November 1968.

Notice is hereby given that the Blackburn County Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which will be to restrict parking in the lengths of street specified in the Schedule.
