PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

HALE URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Hale Urban District Council (No. 2) Smoke Control Order 1968

Notice is hereby given that the Hale Urban District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 31st day of December 1968, made an Order entitled "The Hale Urban District Council (No. 2) Smoke Control Order, 1968", declaring the area described in the First Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel.

The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of October 1969, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, "Halecroft", 253 Hale Road, Hale, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from the 10th January 1969.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

(The Smoke Control Area)

The area referred to is that contained within a line commencing at the junction of Victoria Road and Hale Road and running in a southerly direction following the urban district boundary down Victoria Road, crossing the railway line to the east side of Brown Street, following the boundary this side of Brown Street and thence along the rear boundary of the properties fronting the north side of Ashley Road to the junction of Ashley Road and Peel Avenue, continuing then along the west side of Peel Avenue (but excluding the properties fronting on to the west side of Peel Avenue) to its junction with the northern boundary of the Altrincham Boys' Grammar School Playing Fields; thence in easterly and southerly directions following the boundary of the Grammar School Playing Fields to the railway line; thence in a northerly direction along the line of railway track to the level crossings at Ashley Road;

thence in a south-easterly direction along the centre of Ashley Road to its junction with Westgate; thence in a north-easterly direction along the centre of Westgate to its junction with Broomfield Lane; thence in an easterly direction along the centre of Broomfield Lane to its junction with Hale Road; and thence in a westerly direction along the centre of Hale Road to its junction with Victoria Road.

(Explanatory Note: Reference should be made to the map which is available for inspection, but the above area includes some or all of the buildings in the following roads:—Albert Road, Albert Road East, Ashley Road, Bath Place, Broom Road, Broomfield Lane, Grove Road, Hale Road, Hale View, Hazelwood Road, Heath Road, Lisson Grove, Peel Avenue, Peel Causeway, Seddon Road, Spring Road, Thorn Grove, Utley Field View, Victoria Road and Westgate.)

Notice is hereby given that the Mansfield Woodhouse Urban District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 31st December 1968, made an Order entitled "The Mansfield Woodhouse Urban District Council (No. 2) Smoke Control Order, 1968" declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20, unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of November 1970, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Offices of the Clerk of the Council, Manor House, Mansfield Woodhouse, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from the 16th January 1969.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
