

## SCHEDULE 1

*Lengths of the Folkestone-Brighton-Southampton-Dorchester-Honiton Trunk Road (A.31) in the Urban District of Wimborne Minster (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road")*

1. That length of the trunk road, known as King Street, East Street and Leigh Road which extends from the eastern side of its junction with Grammar School Lane to the western side of its junction with Crescent Road.

2. That length of the trunk road, known as Leigh Road which extends from the western side of its junction with Greenclose Lane to a point 174 feet east of the eastern side of its junction with Gordon Road.

## SCHEDULE 2

*Length of the Folkestone-Brighton-Southampton-Dorchester-Honiton Trunk Road in the Urban District of Wimborne Minster (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road")*

1. That length of the trunk road known as Julian's Road which extends from the eastern end of Julian's Bridge to its junction with King Street.

2. That length of the trunk road, known as King Street, which extends from its junction with West Street to the eastern side of its junction with Grammar School Lane.

3. That length of the trunk road known as West Street, which extends from its junction with King Street to its junction with The Square.

4. The western side of that length of the trunk road, known as The Square (western arm) which extends from its junction with West Street to its junction with West Borough.

5. The northern side of that length of the trunk road, known as The Square (northern arm) which extends from its junction with West Borough to a point 111 feet east of that junction.

6. The eastern side of that length of the trunk road, known as The Square (eastern arm) which extends from its junction with East Borough to a point 45 feet north of its junction with Mill Lane.

7. The southern side of that length of the trunk road, known as The Square (southern arm) which extends from its junction with High Street to its junction with Church Street.

8. The eastern side of that length of the trunk road, known as High Street and The Square (eastern arm) which extends from its junction with Mill Lane to a point 114 feet north of its junction with Cook Row.

9. That length of the trunk road known as High Street which extends from its junction with Cook Row to its junction with East Street.

10. That length of the trunk road, known as Leigh Road which extends from the western side of its junction with Crescent Road to the western side of its junction with Greenclose Lane.

## SCHEDULE 3

*Length and sides of the Folkestone-Brighton-Southampton-Dorchester-Honiton Trunk Road (A.31) in the Urban District of Wimborne Minster (hereinafter known as "the trunk road")*

1. The northern side of that length of the trunk road, known as The Square (northern arm) which extends from a point 129 feet east of its junction with West Borough to a point 111 feet east of that junction.

2. The eastern side of that length of the trunk road known as The Square (eastern arm) which extends from a point 45 feet north of its junction with Mill Lane to that junction.

3. The western side of that length of the trunk road known as High Street which extends from its junction with The Square to a point 114 feet north of its junction with Cook Row.

4. That length of the trunk road known as High Street which extends from a point 114 feet north of its junction with Cook Row to that junction.

### DISEASES OF FISH ACT 1937

## LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1930

### River Ivel Internal Drainage District

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 4(3) and 14 of the Land Drainage Act 1930, as applied by the Water Resources Act 1963, proposes to make an Order confirming a Scheme submitted to him by the Great Ouse River Authority, under section 4 (1) (b) of the Land Drainage Act 1930, making provision for the alteration of the boundaries of the River Ivel Internal Drainage District.

The Scheme affects land in the Urban Districts of Ampthill, Biggleswade and Sandy, the Parishes of Clophill, Flitton, Flitwick, Gravenhurst, Harlington, Higham Gobion, Liddington, Maulden, Millbrook, Pulloxhill, Ridgmont, Shillington, Silsoe, Steppingley, Tingrith and Westoning in the Rural District of Ampthill, the Parish of Roxton in the Rural District of Bedford, the Parishes of Arlesey, Astwick, Blunham, Campton, Chicksands, Clifton, Dunton, Everton, Eyeworth, Henlow, Langford, Meppershall, Mogerhanger, Northill, Old Warden, Potton, Shefford, Southill, Stotfold, Sutton, Tempsford and Upper Stondon in the Rural District of Biggleswade, and the Parishes of Barton-le-Clay, Chalgrave, Streatly, Sundon and Toddington in the Rural District of Luton, all in the administrative County of Bedford; the Parish of Gamlingay in the Rural District of South Cambridgeshire in the administrative County of Cambridgeshire and Isle of Ely; the Urban Districts of Hitchin and Letchworth, and the Parishes of Ashwell, Bygrave, Caldecote, Hexton, Holwell, Ickleford, Newnham, Pirton and Radwell in the Rural District of Hitchin, all in the administrative County of Hertford; and the Parish of Tetworth in the Rural District of St. Neots in the administrative County of Huntingdon and Peterborough.

A copy of the draft Order, together with a copy of the Scheme and of the map referred to therein, has been deposited at the Offices of the River Ivel Internal Drainage Board, 47A Mill Street, Bedford, at the Offices of the Great Ouse River Authority, Great Ouse House, Clarendon Road, Cambridge, and at the Offices of the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, Room 400, Great Westminster House, Horseferry Road, London S.W.1, for public inspection during normal office hours within the period ending with 10th February 1969.
