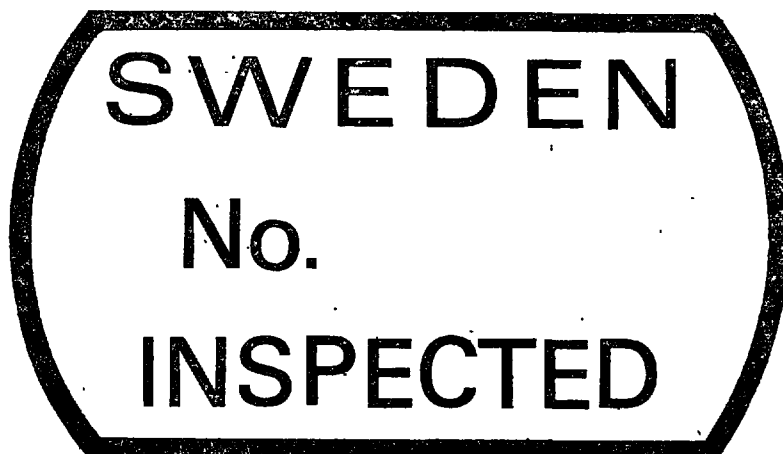

## NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Kent River Authority, by G. T. Jennings & Co. Ltd., Camber Beach Works, Rye, Sussex, for a licence to abstract a maximum of 136,000,000 gallons of water per year from their flooded gravel workings at North Point Beach, Rye, Sussex.
