ATHERTON URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Atherton Urban District Council (No. 5) Smoke Control Order, 1969

Notice is hereby given that the Urban District Council of Atherton in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956, on the 8th day of January 1969, made an Order entitled the Atherton Urban District Council (No. 5) Smoke Control Order, 1969, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the limitations and exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of November 1969, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Atherton, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 17th day of January 1969.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1 object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

An area containing in the whole 115 acres or thereabouts bounded on its several sides by the following:

On the west side from the centre of Market Street near the junction of Bullough Street in a northerly direction and passing to the rear of numbers 21 to 115 Bag Lane to the centre of

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if on any day after the date when the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than the authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of December 1969 or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, Micklefield House, Rawdon, Leeds, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 17th January 1969.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
