The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 3 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pension Act 1865 (28 and 29 Vict. c. 73), and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order and it is hereby ordered as follows: to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

This Order may be cited as the Naval Medical and Dental Officers' (Professional Pay) Order 1969.

Consultant Pay, Specialist Pay and Diploma Pay
2. Consultant, Specialist and Diploma pay shall be
payable, where applicable, to Medical and Dental
Officers of the Royal Navy at the rates and under
the conditions set out in the Schedule to this Order,
irrespective of any provision to the like effect contrined in any Order made under section 3 of the
Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act 1865.

3. The Order in Council (dealing with Medical and Dermal Officers' Specialist Pay and Diploma Pay) dated 28th January 1958 is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

1. Consultant Pay Consultant Pay shall be payable to Medical and Dental Officers appointed as Consultants at the following rates:

Council, the rates shall continue to be payable not-withstanding that any such officer does not at the relevant time hold a consultant appointment.

2. Specialist Pay

2. Specialist Pay shall be payable to Medical and Dental Officers of the rank of Surgeon Captain or Surgeon Captain (D) and below, when nominated as Specialists, at the following rates:

Senior Specialist 0 a day Specialist ... 6 ••• Subject to any instruction issued by the Defence Council, the rates shall continue to be payable notwithstanding that any such officer does not at the relevant time hold a specialist appointment. Specialist Pay shall not be payable concurrently with Consultant Pay.

3. Diploma Pay

Subject to any instruction issued by the Defence Council, Diploma Pay shall be payable at the rate of 4s. 0d. a day to Non-Specialist Medical Officers below the rank of Surgeon Captain who hold one of the following diplomas:

Diploma in Public Health Diploma in Industrial Hygiene Diploma in Tropical Medicine and Hygiene Diploma in Child Health

Diploma of the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists

Diploma in Aviation Medicine.

Diploma Pay shall not be payable concurrently with either Consultant Pay or Specialist Pay.
