The Borough of Bridgwater (Various Streets) (Prohibition and Limitation of Waiting) (Amendment) (No. 6) Order 1969.

Newtown between Hills Road and Trumpington Road

Notice is hereby given that on the 31st day of December 1968, the Cambridge City Council made an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which is as follows:

- 1. To revoke the City of Cambridge (Traffic Regulation) Order (No. 3) 1967, insofar as it relates to the direction of traffic flow in Bateman Street (Trumpington Road to Panton Street).
- To permit vehicular traffic in the following roads to move only in the direction indicated:
 (a) Brookside (Bateman Street to Pemberton Terrace)—south to north;

(b) Panton Street (Russell Street to Lensfield

Road)—south to north;
(c) Union Road—west to east;
(d) Coronation Street (Hills Road to Panton Street)—east to west;
(e) Russell Street—west to east;

(f) Norwich Street—east to west.

3. To prohibit vehicles from waiting at any time on the following lengths of road:

(a) East side of Brookside between its junctions with Pemberton Terrace and Saxon Pemberton Street :

(b) West side of Brookside from its junction with Pemberton Terrace to a point 50 yards north of that junction;
(c) Either side of Pemberton Terrace.
