WALSALL COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Walsall (St. Paul's Street) (Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1968

Notice is hereby given that on the 9th January 1969 the Minister of Transport confirmed the above-named Order made by the Walsall County Borough Council under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicles from using St. Paul's Street, Walsall, between its junction with Hatherton Road and its junction with Darwall Street.

The prohibition will not apply:

- (a) to trolley vehicles or to public service vehicles not being express carriages or contract carriages.
- (b) to vehicles conveying persons or goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to that road.
- (c) to vehicles used in connection with any building or demolition operation or for the maintenance or improvement of the road or of any services therein.
- (d) to vehicles used in connection with statutory powers or duties.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the roads to which the Order relates may be inspected at the office of Town Clerk, The Council House, Lichfield Street, Walsall, during normal office hours.

The Order will come into force on the 23rd January 1969 and will continue on a permanent basis the Experimental Order now in force.

WILTSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Wilts (Various Roads in the Parish of Nettleton) (Weight Restriction) Amendment Order, 1969.
