DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (Dittisham) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Amendment) Order, 1969

Notice is hereby given that on 7th January 1969, the Devon County Council made an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, the effect of which is to vary existing waiting restrictions at Dittisham as follows:

- (a) to prohibit waiting by vehicles at all times in the following lengths of road:

The Lane from its junction with Manor Street to a point 12 yards north of that junction;

Manor Street from a point 15 yards west of its junction with *The Lane* to a point 8 yards east of that junction.

- (b) to prohibit waiting by vehicles at all times from 1st April to 30th September each year in the following lengths of road:

The Quay from its junction with Manor Street to a point 14 yards north of that junction;

Manor Street from a point 8 yards east of its junction with *The Lane* to its junction with *The Quay*.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to permit waiting for the purpose of boarding or alighting from vehicles; loading or unloading goods; building operations, road maintenance and repairs and other similar works; and to enable vehicles to take in petrol, oil, water or air from a garage.
